1st floor: Community Care

- All close contacts tested negative on Day 6.
- Residents are off isolation today.
- Residents can go to dining room, eat at their regular tables. Cannot go to second or third floor.
- Remain at 1 PIC.
- We are not sure about drives, outings - so no going out yet.
- Can go outdoors for a walk.

2nd floor: Nursing Care

- Carriage House:
 - All residents tested negative. No close contacts.
 - Residents are off isolation today.
 - Residents must remain in Carriage House.
 - Remain at 1 PIC.
- Hilltop View:
 - 2 positive cases - initial case March 10 and a subsequent case on March 15. Everyone else in the neighborhood (the other 14 residents) are negative on Day 6 testing.
 - All residents remain on contact-droplet precautions.
 - Remain at 1 PIC.

- St. Dunstan's:
 - 1 positive case March 17. No close contacts.
 - All residents remain on isolation. Symptomatic residents remain on contact-droplet precautions.
 - Remain at 1 PIC.

Partners in Care will now be given test kits to take home - please pick up a test kit (3 tests inside) when you are here. Do a rapid antigen test before you come to visit. You do not need to show proof.
