SUBJECT: OVERNIGHT STAYS
DATE: SEPTEMBER 8, 2020

Guidance for Overnight Stays:

1. Any or all of the Essential Support Person(s) (ESP) may take the resident for an overnight stay.
2. The Essential Support Person (ESP) must wear a medical mask when 2 meters of distance cannot be maintained. The Mount can provide the mask.
3. The Essential Support Person(s) (ESP) must be screened by staff prior to the overnight stay.
4. The resident **may not have contact with others during the overnight stay**. The overnight stay must be coordinated with the supervisor. At this time we are allowing 1 night for the overnight stay.
5. The resident may go to any location for the overnight stay, as long as they are with the Essential Support Person.
6. Hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette must be followed at all times.
7. Keep the circle of contact small. A large gathering during an overnight stay is not appropriate for the resident.

8. Remember, the resident may not have contact with others during the overnight stay.

The supervisor will decide if the resident and their Essential Support Person(s) have a plan that meets all the criteria above, and follows the directive from the Chief Public Health Office. Please ensure adequate notice for the supervisor to review the plan. The supervisor may or may not approve the request.

In some cases, the supervisor may require the approval of the Director of Nursing or the Administrator.
