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**CPHO has just released a recommendation that all Community Care and Long-term Care facilities adopt a masking policy, for visitors and staff, for the upcoming season. This is in response to yearly trends related to respiratory illnesses in PEI**

**At this point in time, we are requesting all staff and visitors wear a mask, upon entry, to the Mount. Masks are provided by The Mount at the entry to the building and households.**

We also ask that all residents and visitors practice hand hygiene frequently. Alcohol dispensers are available throughout the building. Please ensure to follow precautions sign instructions posted on the resident's door, if the resident you are visiting is in isolation. In the event of an outbreak, we will send specific communications related to that event.

We appreciate that public health officials, administrators and staff of all facilities are working together to provide the safest care for the residents.
